TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Your prices/rates must been FOB/FCA basis up to international Airport including inland freight including /documentation charges etc. bifurcating CIF value.
- 2. Freight and insurance will be arranged by NPL.
- 3. The mode of dispatch to be followed by you must be indicated and tentative size and weight of consignment may also be indicated in the quotation.
- 4. **PERIOD OF DELIVERY**: The delivery period is the essence of supply; hence it must be indicated specifically in the quotation. Please note that delivery period in case of sight payment, will be determined from the date of Order acknowledgement, which has to be submitted within 21 days of the placement of purchase order. In the case of supplies against LC payment the date of delivery will commence from opening of clear LC.
- 5. All bank charges in the exporting country will be on the exporters account.
- 6. The relevant blue/catalogue/pamphlets/literature and Instruction Manual must be attached along with your quotation/performs invoice. Without supporting relevant catalogues, quoted specification may not be evaluated technically.
- 7. The shipment through courier services may not be acceptable in normal circumstances.
- 8. The shipment must be affected through our consolidation agent. The details of our consolidation agent will be indicated in our order.
- 9. PAYMENT: (a) The payment for imported goods shall be made through irrevocable L/C for 100% value, out of which 90% shall be released against presentation of complete shipping documents & 10% after satisfactory installation of goods at NPL subject to submission of PBG for 10% value of goods to cover warranty period plus sixty days. Alternatively 10% Thr. TT after completion of warranty period of goods against required PBG.
 - **(b)** The payment against indigenous supplies shall be made direct to the suppliers through RTGS: 100% shall be released on bill basis after satisfactory installation of material at NPL subject to submission of PBG for 10% value of goods to cover warranty period plus sixty days. OR 10% after completion of warranty.
- **10.** Taxes as applicable. We are exempted for GST for scientific equipment as per Ministry of Finance Department of Revenue notification no. 47/2017 and 45/2017 dated 14.11.2017 for IGST @ 5% CGST @ 2.5% and SGST @ 2.5%.
- 11. AUTHORIZATION OF INDIAN AGENTS & INDIAN REPRESENTATIVE:
 - **a.** In case there is involvement of an /Indian agent/representative in any form as mentioned at (b) below, an authority letter / copy of agreement from the principal manufacturer must be submitted with the quotation.
 - b. Where quoting party/Indian representative claims to be the subsidiary or branch office or an authorized representative of the principal foreign manufacturer/supplier in India, then a copy of approval from RBI/DGS&D for operating business in India as Subsidiary/Branch/Liaison office or Joint-Venture may be submitted with offer.
- **12. COMMENCEMENT OF WARRANTY PERIOD**: The warranty period, of an item shall commence from the date of satisfactory installation at the project site in National Physical Laboratory, New Delhi.
- 13. INSTALLATION & TRAINING: to be arranged by supplier/its Indian agent immediately of receipt of goods but not later than sixty days of receipt of good at NPL.
- 14. **PENALTY CLAUSE**: In case of delay in supply on part of the supplier, a penalty @ 0.5% per week subject to maximum 10% of Order/FOB value will be charged for delayed period both in late delivery & installation.
- DISPUTE SETTLEMENT: The Purchaser and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract...If, after twenty-one (21) days, the parties have failed to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation, then either the Purchaser or the Supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration, as hereinafter provided, as to the matter in dispute, and no arbitration in respect of this matter may be commenced unless such notice is given. Any dispute or difference in respect of which a notice of intention to commence arbitration has been given in accordance with this Clause shall be finally settled by arbitration. Arbitration may be commenced prior to or after delivery of the Goods under the Contract. The dispute settlement mechanism/arbitration proceedings shall be concluded as under:
- (a) In case of Dispute or difference arising between the Purchaser and a domestic supplier relating to any matter arising out of or connected with this agreement, such disputes or difference shall be settled in accordance with the Indian Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996, the rules there under and any statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof shall apply to the arbitration proceedings. The dispute shall be referred to the Director General, Council of Scientific & Industrial Research and if he is unable to unwilling to act, to the sole arbitration of some other person appointed by his willing to act as such Arbitrator. The award of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to this order.
- (b) In the case of a dispute between the Purchase and a Foreign suppler, the dispute shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with provision of sub-clause (a) above. But if this is not acceptable to the supplier then the dispute shall be settled in accordance with provisions of UNCITRAL (United Nations Commission on International Trade Law) Arbitration Rules.
