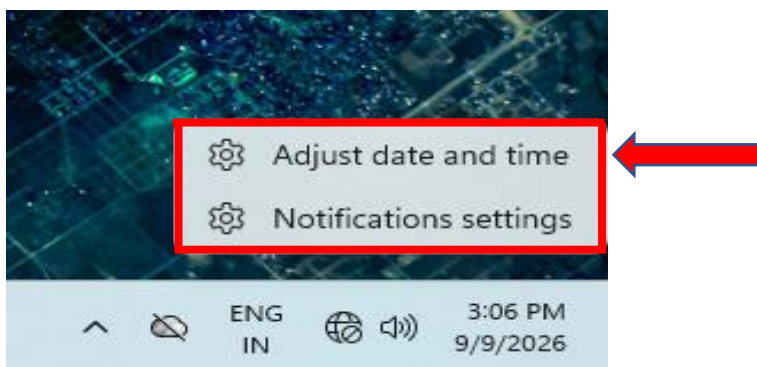


Indian Standard Time (IST)[®] can be synchronized over the Internet using the NPL time servers through the domain names **time.nplindia.org** or **time.nplindia.in**.

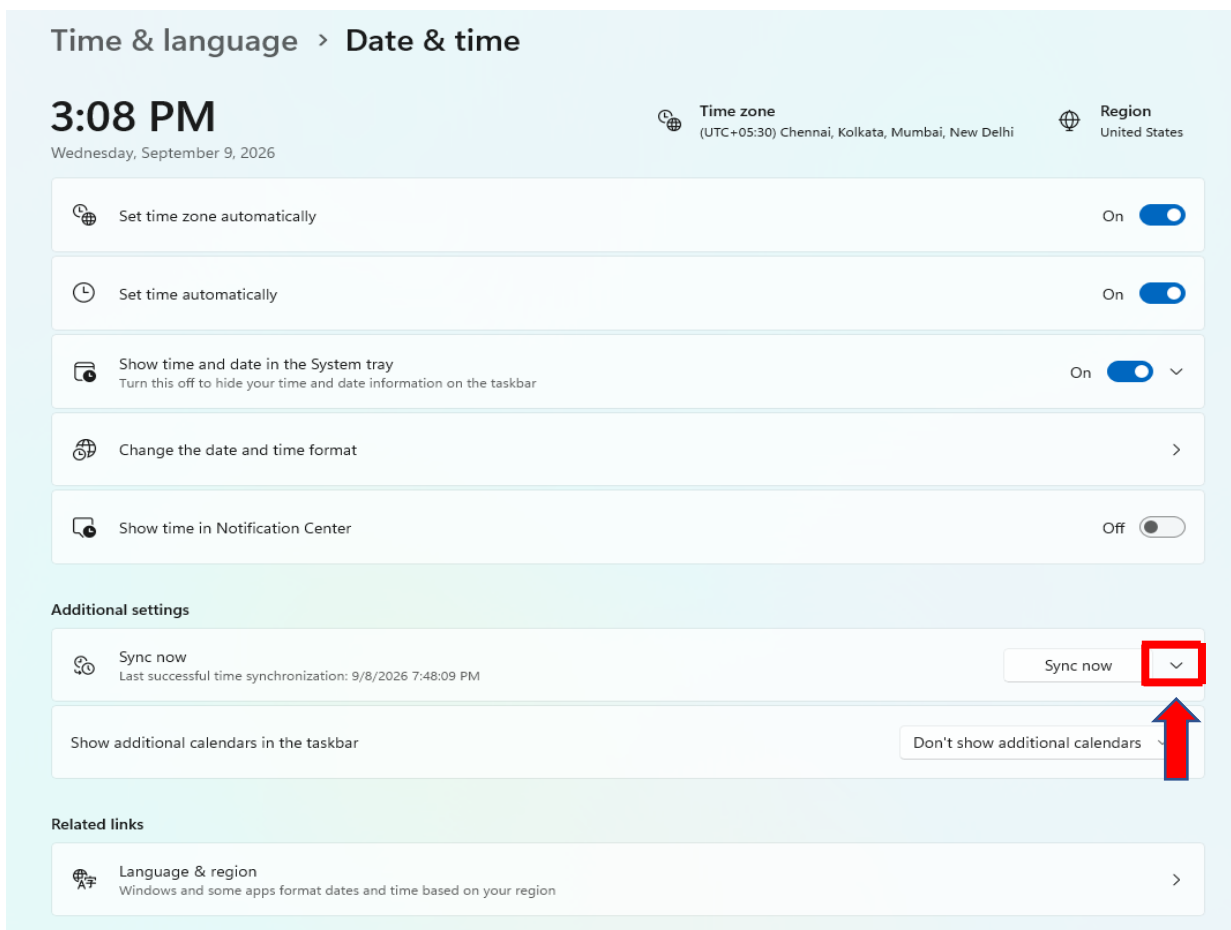
The following step-by-step procedures can be followed to synchronize a Windows computer with IST for Windows 11 and older version of Windows operating systems

➔ Synchronize Windows 11 Clock with IST[®] – (Indian Standard Time) using NPL India Time Server

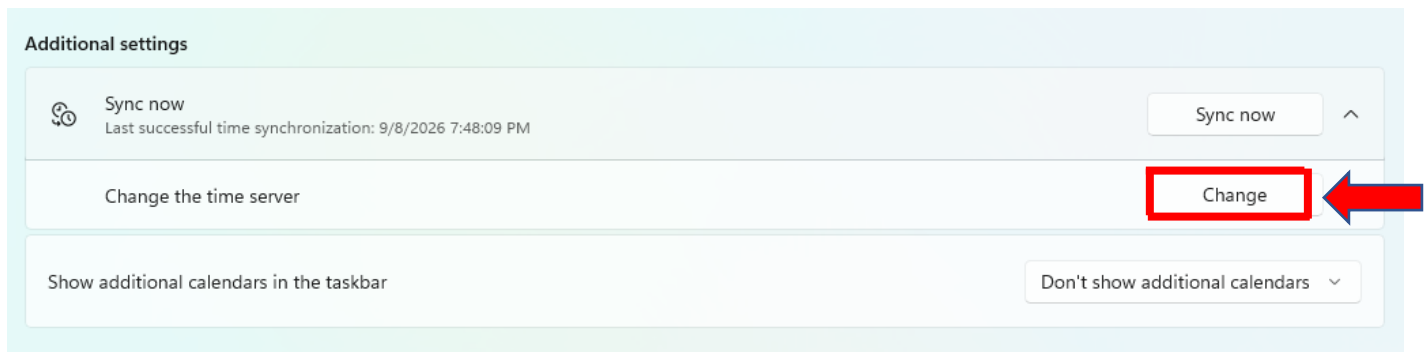
Step 1 : Right-click at the clock shown in bottom right corner of the PC at taskbar, choose **Adjust date and time**



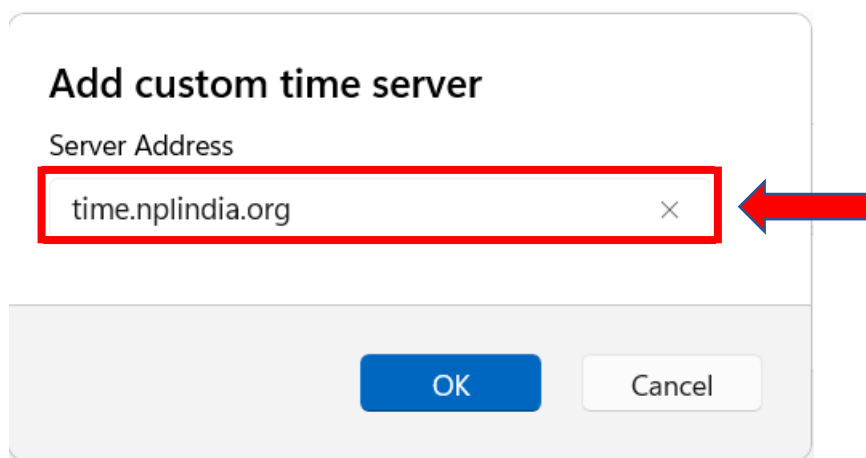
Step 2: Then this window will pop-up, Click on the **Arrow next to Sync now**



Step 3: Then, this window will pop-up and Click on the **Change**.

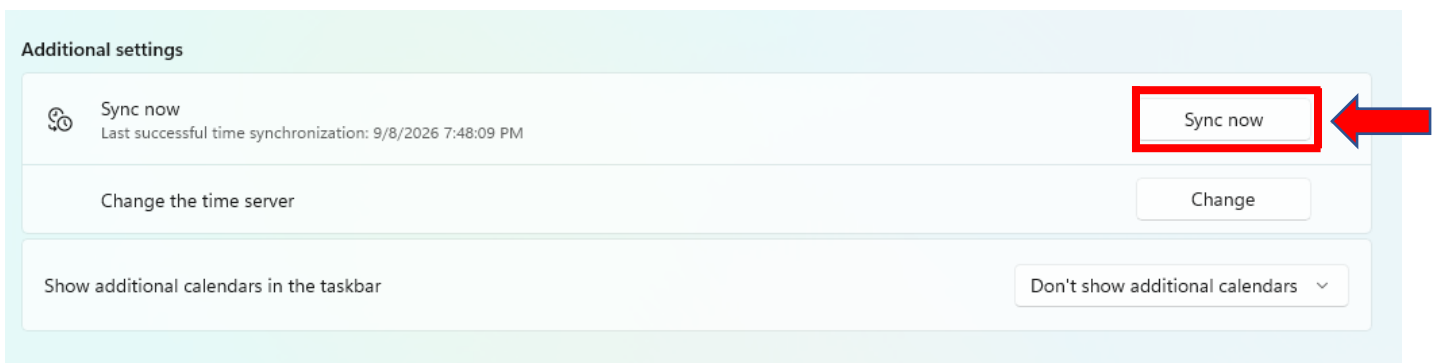


Step 4 : Add custom time server window will pop-up, Replace the default time server with **time.nplindia.org** or **time.nplindia.in**



Click **OK**

Step 5 : If the clock is not synchronized successfully, Click **Sync Now** again.



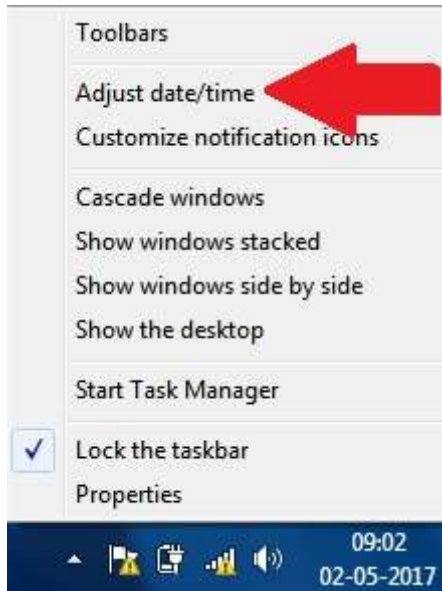

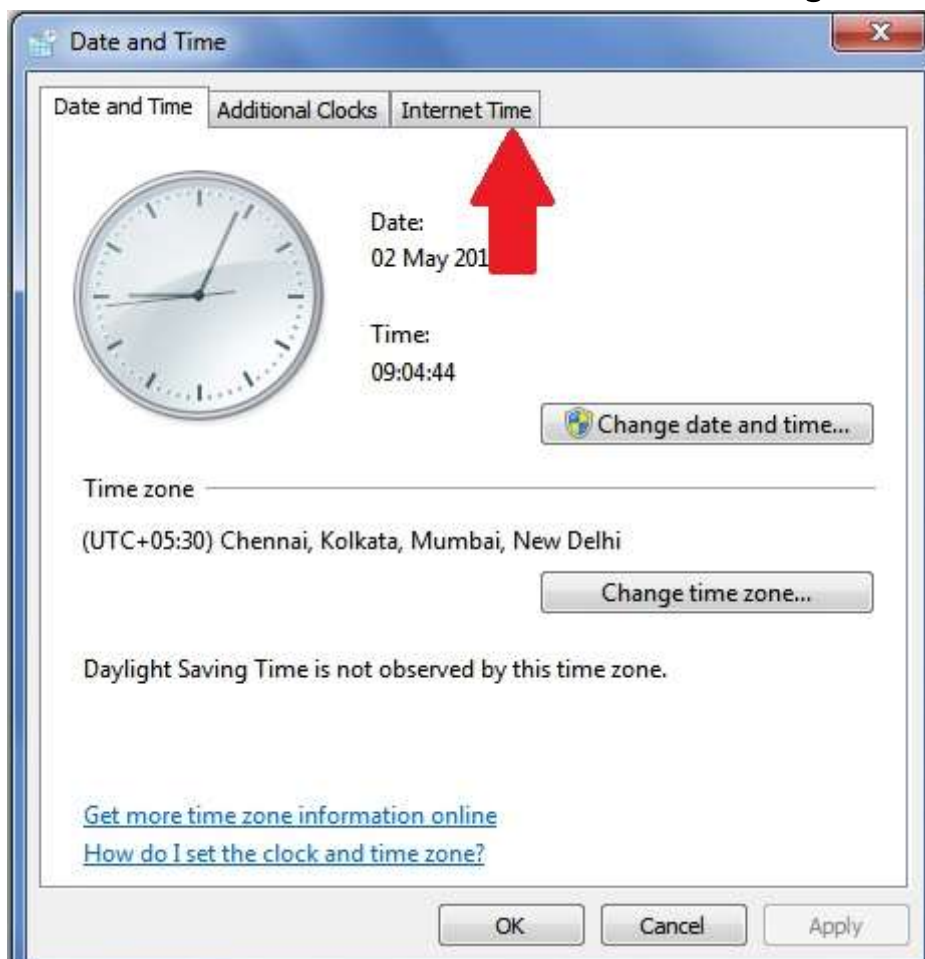

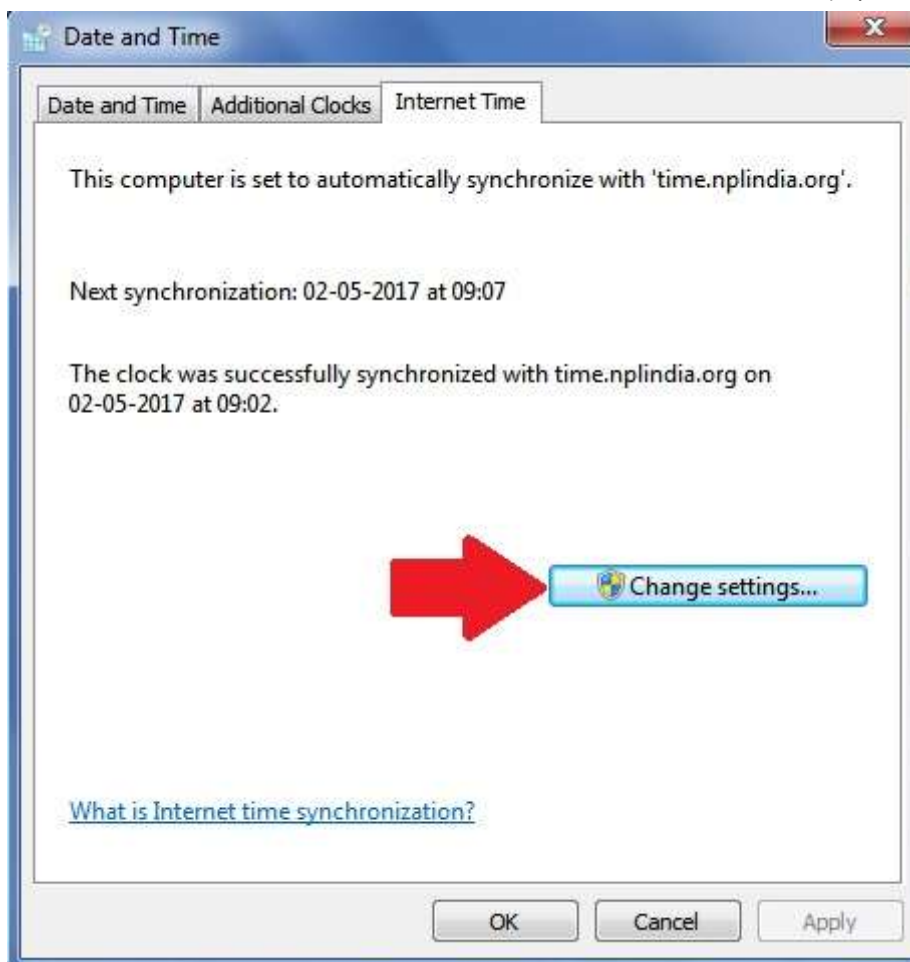
Synchronize Windows Clock With NPL India Time Server

- Right-click your clock and choose **Adjust date/time**

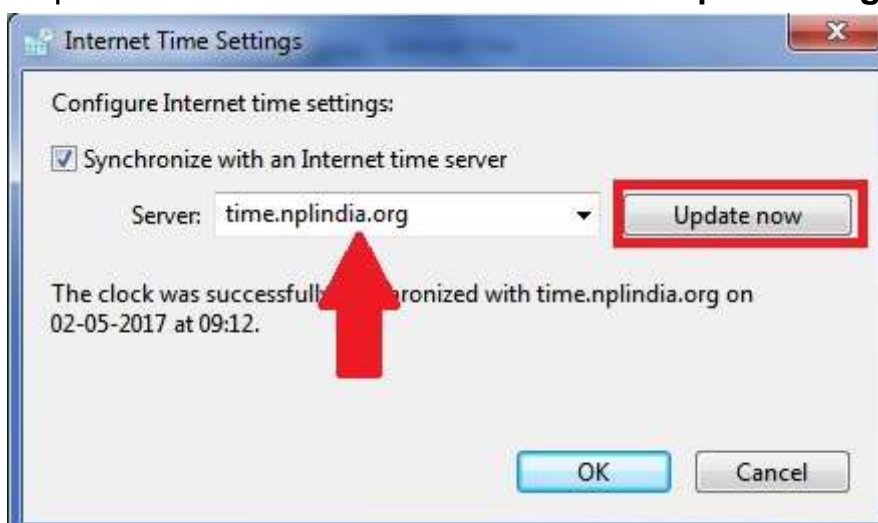


- Click on the **Internet Time** tab and then the **Change Settings** button





- Replace the default time server with **time.nplindia.org**



- Click **Update Now**
- If the clock is not synchronized successfully, Click **Update Now** again
